

Rotations Participant Checklist

1. Review Rotation Opportunities

- Visit the [About Rotations page](#) to understand available locations, rotation details, and associated costs.

2. DOCARE Membership

- Ensure you are a current, dues-paying member of DOCARE. If you are not yet a Member, [join today!](#)

3. Application Submission

- Complete and [submit the online application form](#). A nonrefundable \$50 application fee is required at the time of submission.


4. University/Residency Approval

- Seek approval from your home institution, as most require prior approval several months in advance of travel.

5. Rotation Fee

- Upon acceptance, the remaining \$950 of the \$1,000 DOCARE Rotation Fee is due to confirm and hold your rotation.

6. Travel Arrangements

- Passport and Visa: Ensure your passport is valid for at least 6 months beyond your final travel date and obtain any necessary visas.
 - Flights and Lodging: Arrange transportation and accommodations per the rotation site's guidelines.
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7. Medical Preparations

- Vaccinations: Consult a travel medicine clinic for required immunizations.
- Health Precautions: [Review health and safety guidelines for DOCARE volunteers](#) and [review guidelines set by the CDC](#).

8. Insurance Requirements

- Obtain medical and evacuation insurance with a minimum of \$500,000 in coverage, including repatriation. [One of many options is provided here](#).

9. Personal Documentation

- Carry printed and digital copies of your passport, insurance policy, and emergency contacts.
- Register your travel with the [Smart Traveler Enrollment Program \(STEP\)](#).

10. Pre-Departure Preparation

- Review packing lists and pre-trip resources provided by DOCARE.
- Maintain communication with DOCARE staff and your Rotation Leader after acceptance.
